It is said that the lanterns bestowed by Emperor Jiaqing of the Qing Dynasty on the brother and sister-in-law of General Wang Delu were moved to the temple to be shared, allowing Peitian Temple in Taiwan to contain imperially gifted lanterns, resulting in a place where people can pray for children. During the Japanese colonial period, it was rebuilt by the Zhangpai master carpenter Chen Yingbin, who presided over the "Duichang" construction, resulting in the creation of multiple national treasures for generations to enjoy.

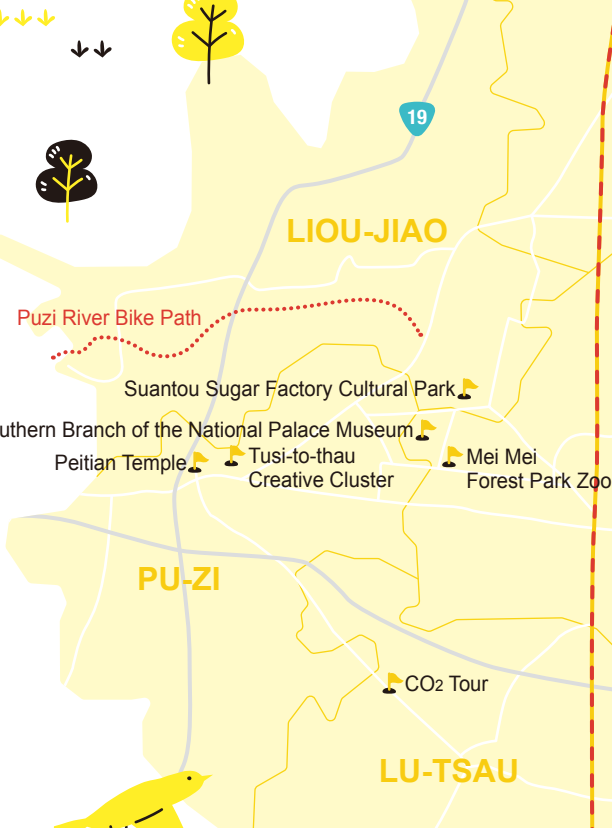

Pei Gui Hall

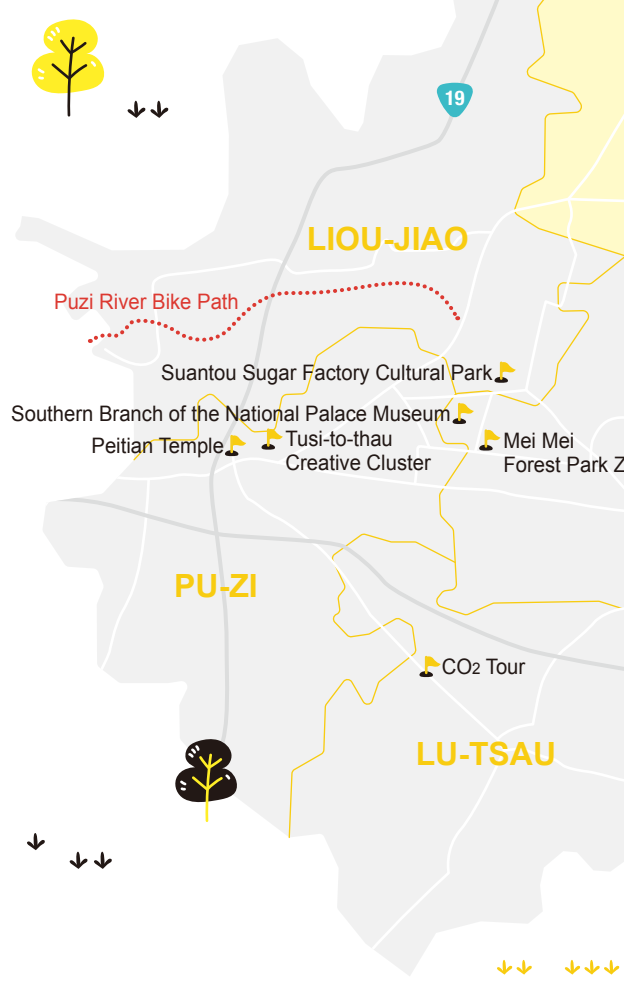

Fengtian Temple

Singang Fengtian Temple has been rebuilt many times, and the craftsmen mostly come from the Cantonese system. The temple has the styles of Cantonese craftsmen from different periods. The most brilliant Sanchuan Hall retains the works of the famous craftsman Wu Hattong during the Japanese colonial period. When the Chien Nian was renovated, it was decorated with the Coochin ceramics of the famous craftsman Hung Kunfu. In addition to the main deity, Mazu, the most special thing is that the temple enshrines the Top Scholar Tiger God with an imperial gifted golden flower on its head, and its spirit is distributed to various places in Taiwan.

The highest point of Haishu Mountain is at an altitude of 1,314 meters. From the 1314 Observation Deck, you can have a 360-degree view of the beautiful tea plantations on Haishu Mountain. The white "1314 Love Tower" is set up on the side, and the undulating green tea plantations are like pieces of matcha cake, with stunning scenery that instantly heals the soul.

The Green Tunnel

Yuyupas is a Cou language term, representing the blessing of "prosperous and healthy" in both spirit and material. The park has a cultural and historical museum, Matano Theatre, traditional houses, restaurants, etc., and five tea houses built in the style of traditional Cou thatched huts, allowing visitors to get a glimpse of the beauty of Alishan and Cou culture. Cayamavana (Right)

Cayamavana was originally called Jayama, meaning "the plain on the mountainside". 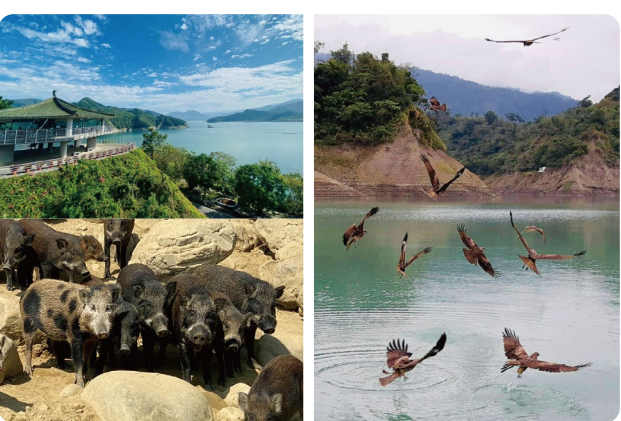

Tapangu

One of the two major tribes of the Cou people in Dabang, which still retains traditional customs, rituals, and cultural relics to this day. Traditional rituals include miapo (millet planting festival), homeyaya (millet harvest festival), mayavi, etc. The rich natural ecology and trails that serve as both hunting and war paths make it the best place to experience Cou culture.

Zengwen Reservoir Lake Tour

Zengwen Reservoir has a vast catchment area and is the largest reservoir in Taiwan. The lake tour departs from the observation tower by boat, circling around the Flying Eagle Canyon, Boar Island and other beautiful scenery, taking in the full view of the lake and mountains. Wild boars gather in groups on Boar Island. Whenever a sightseeing boat approaches and plays music, the boars follow the sound and come, and the interesting scene of them swimming for food is very healing.

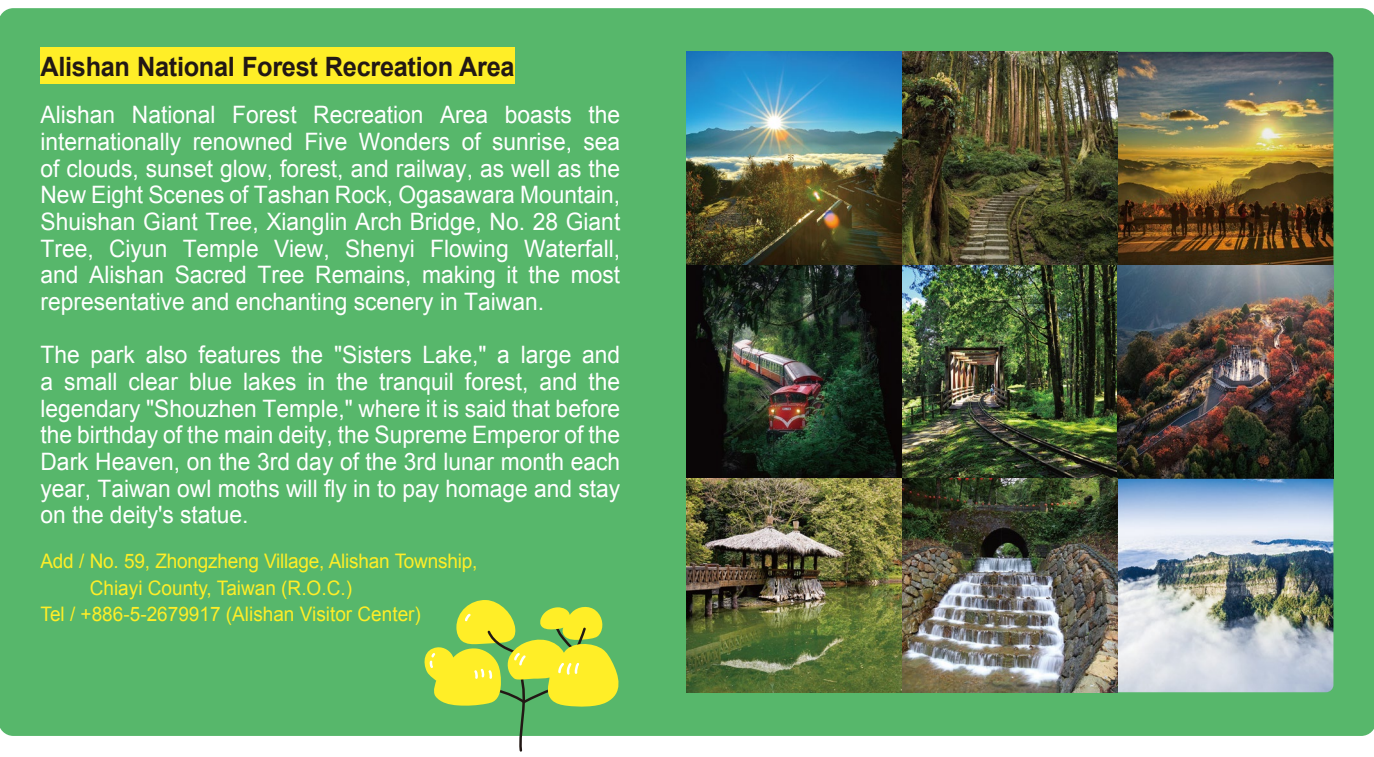

Eryanping Trail

The trail is about 1,150 meters long, with beautiful scenery along the way, alternating between tea plantations and bamboo forests. It overlooks the Chianan Plain, Renyitan Reservoir, Lantan Reservoir, and Zengwen Reservoir. On clear days, Yushan Main Peak can be seen. It is a famous spot for photographers to capture sea of clouds, cloud waterfalls, and sunsets.

Alishan National Forest Recreation Area boasts the internationally renowned Five Wonders of sunrise, sea of clouds, sunset glow, forest, and railway, as well as the New Eight Scenes of Tashan Rock, Ogasawara Mountain, Shuishan Giant Tree, Xianglin Arch Bridge, No. 23 Giant Tree, Cuyun Temple View, Sherry Flowing Mountain, and Alishan Sacred Tree Remains, making it the most representative and enchanting scenery in Taiwan.

The park also features the "Sisters Lake," a large and a small clear blue lakes in the tranquil forest, and the legendary "Shouzhen Temple," where it is said that before the birthday of the main deity, the Supreme Emperor of the Dark Heaven, on the 3rd day of the 3rd lunar month each year, Taiwan owl moths will fly in to pay homage and stay on the deity's statue.

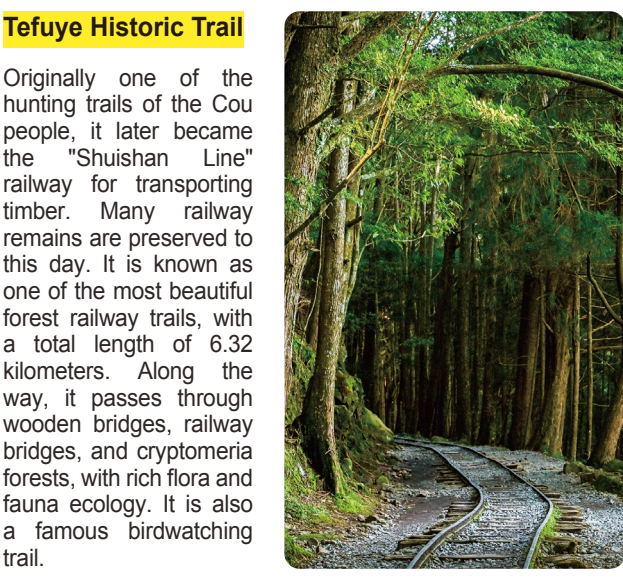

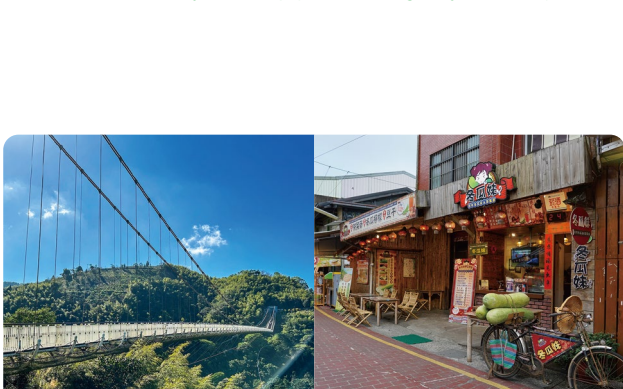

Tefuye Historic Trail

Originally one of the hunting trails of the Cou people, it later became the "Shuishan Line" railway for transporting timber. Many railway remains are preserved to this day. It is known as one of the most beautiful forest railway trails, with a total length of 6.32 kilometers. Along the way, it passes through wooden bridges, railway bridges, and cryptomeria forests, with rich flora and fauna ecology. It is also a famous birdwatching trail.

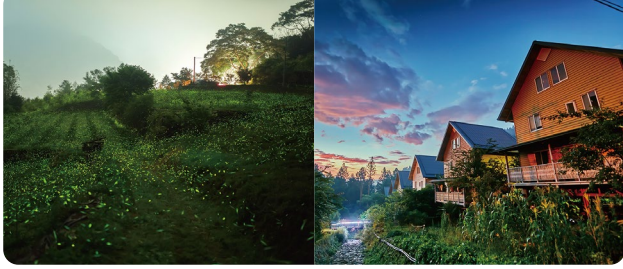
